## Antique Tractor Pull

**Entry Fee:** \$20.00 (Includes 2 pit pass)

**Pit Pass:** \$15.00

**Premiums:** 1<sup>st</sup>-\$150, 2<sup>nd</sup>-\$120, 3<sup>rd</sup>-\$100, 4<sup>th</sup>-\$90, 5<sup>th</sup>-\$80, 6<sup>th</sup>-\$70, 7<sup>th</sup>-\$60, 8<sup>th</sup>-\$50, 9<sup>th</sup>-\$40, 10<sup>th</sup>-\$30

### **Antique Class 1959 and Older**

1505-1 6500 lb or less

#### **Rules for Antique Class**

1. Same entry tractor limited to one pull per class.
2. Tires must be single 18.4 x 38 size limit. **Cut tires are allowed.**
3. Any Gear. No RPM limit.
4. Stock appearing block or factory replacement that conforms to tractor model being entered. **No turbos.**

## Farm Tractors

#### **Rules for Farm Classes**

1. No cut or shaved tires allowed. **2 WD Only.**
2. **20.8 x 38 size limit. No Duals allowed.**
3. Farm use tractors with O.E.M. equipment. (**engine, powertrain, injection pump, turbo, wheels, hubs, etc.**)
4. Engine speed limited to 3000 RPM maximum.

**(Will not be checked before pulling due to safety but if Officials deem necessary to check after pulling and you are over you will be disqualified )**

5. Drawbar **must** be in the original factory position. Pulling loop, clevis, or pulling drawbar allowed.

**Official Rules 2009**  
**General Rules - Tractor Pull All Classes**

1. Drivers must be **16 years or older**, Under 18 must have parents written permission. No person(s) under 16 allowed inside track gate due to insurance regulations.
2. **Any use of alcoholic beverages will cause disqualification.**
3. Drivers must operate in safe manner at all times, one hand on the steering wheel and a foot or hand near clutch. No standing up during pull.
4. Tractors must have serial number in proper place. Engine and drive line must be original for that model. **No pressurized fuel systems except factory LP.** No nitrous-oxide, methane or any other type mixture.
5. **All tractors must be two-wheel driven. No crawlers. No front wheel or 4 wd's allowed. No duals allowed unless otherwise stated.**
6. Drawbar height maximum 20 inches from ground to top of hitch. Minimum length of 18 inches from center of rear axle to hitch point. Must have clevis or 3 inch diameter pulling eye.
7. Weights added to change classes must be secure, falling off will cause disqualification. Weights must not extend more than **twenty four inches** (24") beyond front of tractor.
8. **Tractor must stop when flagged by judge or will be disqualified.** Tractor will be flagged when going out of bounds or front end raises up too high. Any tractor stopped in first 25 feet will get one repull.
9. **Any protest must be lodged within 10 minutes of the last pull in that class. A \$ 150.00 protest fee is required at the time protest is filed.**
10. All tractors will be inspected and weighed on the grounds before and after each class pulled.
11. Officials reserve the right to reject any or all entries.
12. **Judges & Officials decisions are final and take precedent over printed material.**
